

HIGHLIGHTS OF BUENOS AIRES

PRE- AND POST-EXPEDITION LAND PROGRAM | DURATION: 3 DAYS/2 NIGHTS



DAY 1

Upon arriving in Buenos Aires, you will be met and greeted to transfer to your hotel. For guests arriving in the morning, you may drop off your luggage, and for guests arriving after 3PM, you will be able to check-in upon arrival.

12:30 PM – 1:45 PM | Enjoy a 15-minute walk to a nearby restaurant for an included lunch. For the next hour, savor authentic Argentinian cuisine.

2 PM – 5 PM | Explore Puerto Madero with a 3-hour walking tour, stopping at shops along the way. One of the main stunning features of the port is Puente de la Mujer (Bridge of the Woman), a marvelous piece of engineering that is also art.

5 PM – 7 PM | After your walking tour, return to your hotel for an included dinner before settling in for a night of rest. You will either eat at the hotel restaurant or go to a nearby restaurant.

DAY 2

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel before your day begins.

9 AM – 9:45 AM | Board a bus for a 15-minute transfer to begin your panoramic tour of Buenos Aires' highlights. Explore Plaza de Mayo (May Square), the oldest public square in Buenos Aires, for 30 minutes. It's here you find many historical landmarks, including the famous Casa Rosada.

9:45 AM – **10:30 AM** | Hop back on your coach for a 15-minute transfer to La Boca neighborhood. Here, for the next 30 minutes, the vibrant colors of the houses pay homage to the working-class history of the city. Retaining strong influences of its Italian settlers, it holds a romantic atmosphere that's prime for the tango performances you'll find on almost any street corner.

10:30 AM - 12:15 PM | Sit back and enjoy the ride on a 45-minute transfer to Recoleta Cemetery. Here begins your 30-minute excursion exploring where the rich and famous of the past are buried. With over 6,400 crypts, statues, coffins and sarcophagi – among them one of the most famous being Eva "Evita" Perón's – this labyrinthine city of the dead beckons you to step back in time and explore some of the country's most fascinating history.

12:15 PM – 1:30 PM | After your visit to Recoleta, your bus will take you on a 15-minute transfer to an included lunch at a local restaurant. Savor authentic Argentinian cuisine with a leisurely hour-long lunch.

1:30 PM – 2 PM | Transfer back to the hotel to rest and refresh before the rest of your night continues.

DAY 2 (CONTINUED)

7 PM – 10 PM | Get swept away by the romance and passion of the traditional dance with a 3-hour show. As you revel in a night of tango, enjoy a delicious dinner of authentic Argentinian cuisine.

10 PM | Once your night winds down, you will take a 15-minute transfer back to the hotel for a night of rest.

DAY 3

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel. Check out and be transferred to the airport for the journey back home if you're enjoying the post-expedition land program. Or if you're enjoying the pre-expedition land program, you'll be transferred to the airport to fly to Ushuaia where you'll embark on your Antarctica expedition.

EXPLORING IGUAZÚ FALLS

PRE-EXPEDITION LAND PROGRAM | DURATION: 4 DAYS/3 NIGHTS



DAY 1

Upon arriving in Buenos Aires at the beginning of your Antarctic expedition, you will be met and greeted to transfer to your hotel. For guests arriving in the morning, you may drop off your luggage, and for guests arriving after 3 PM, you will be able to check-in upon arrival.

12:30 PM – 1:45 PM | Enjoy a 15-minute walk to a nearby restaurant for an included lunch. For the next hour, savor authentic Argentinian cuisine.

1:45 PM – 3:30 PM | Following your lunch, take a 15-minute walk to the famous Recoleta Cemetery. For the next 90 minutes, discover where the rich and famous of the past are buried. With over 6,400 crypts, statues, coffins and sarcophagi – among them one of the most famous being Eva "Evita" Perón's – this labyrinthine city of the dead beckons you to step back in time and explore some of the country's most fascinating history.

3:30 PM – 4:30 PM | From Recoleta Cemetery, it's a 30-minute walk through the magnificent architecture of Buenos Aires to arrive at El Ateneo Grand Splendid. For the next 30 minutes, this stunning bookshop, once a historic theater, invites you to marvel over its ornate details, frescoed ceilings, elegant balconies, luxurious, red curtains and seemingly endless rows of books.

4:30 PM – 5 PM | Enjoy a 30-minute leisurely stroll back to the hotel to check in, pick up your luggage and rest and refresh for the evening.

6:30 PM – 9:30 PM | Once you've rested, the adventure continues with a 30-minute transfer to an included dinner for Argentinian cuisine. Along with a delicious meal, enjoy an authentic tango show for 2.5 hours for an evening of pure revelry.

 $9:\!30$ PM | A 15-minute transfer brings you back to the hotel for the night to rest for the next day's explorations.

DAY 2

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel before your day begins.

7 AM – 11 AM | Take a 15-minute transfer to the Buenos Aires Airport. Here, your 90-minute flight to the Iguazú International Airport departs at 9 AM.

 ${\bf 11~AM-12~PM}$ | You will be met and greeted at the airport for your transfer to the hotel.

12 PM - 1:30 PM | Enjoy an included lunch at the restaurant inside the national park.

1:30 PM | Immerse yourself in the enchanting scenery of Iguazú Falls — one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World and also declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site — from the upper circuit on the Argentina side. An area of 275 unique waterfalls and lush islands, these cascades are a remarkable gift from the planet for all your senses.

Evening | After an exciting day of exploring one of Earth's most stunning natural wonders, enjoy dinner at the hotel and rest up for the next day.

DAY 3

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel and then transfer back to the falls.

8:30 AM – 12:30 PM | Witness the awe-inspiring power of Devil's Throat, the largest curtain with 14 waterfalls in the shape of a horseshoe. Dropping over 260 feet down into the white foam of rapids indistinguishable from the perpetual mist, these cascades are truly a sight to behold.

Explore the falls further with an exciting 20-minute Zodiac safari, included in your 4-hour excursion, around the cascades. Coming close to the rushing waters of these magnificent waterfalls, a sense of reverence may overcome you as you listen to the sound of their mighty stream.

12:30 PM – 1:30 PM | Once your trek comes to an end, you will return to the hotel for lunch and to gather your belongings.

2:30 PM – 5 PM | A 15-minute transfer takes you and your fellow explorers back to the Iguazú International Airport. Your 90-minute flight back to Buenos Aires departs at 3:30 PM. Upon arrival at the Buenos Aires Airport, you will be greeted here and transferred to your hotel.

 ${\bf 7\,PM}\,|\,$ Enjoy an evening of dinner on your own and find your own adventures before resting.

DAY 4

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel and check out. You will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Ushuaia as you prepare to embark on your Antarctica expedition.
